# Introduction

Coral reefs are home to many sea creatures. Some, such as the brightly coloured butterfly fish, are very beautiful. Others, such as the hammerhead shark, look very strange! Its eyes are set into either side of its hammer-shaped head. Manta rays glide elegantly through the water, whilst shoals of smaller fish dart past. Large fish, such as barracudas, hunt for their next meal. They have deadly, razor-



The woodlands come alive at night when many animals come out to feed or hunt their prey. During the summer months, animals such as squirrels and hedgehogs feed on fruit and nuts

from the trees. During the winter, food is more difficult to find. The trees lose their leaves, many birds fly away to warmer lands and some animals hibernate (go into a long sleep) until spring.
